100 Voices: A Journey Home

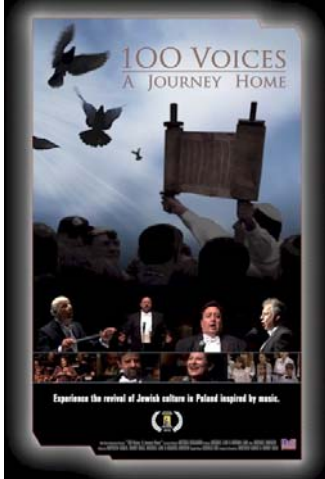

A documentary look at Polish/Jewish history and culture and its current resurgence. The story is told through the personal reflections and musical performances of a group of Cantors and acclaimed composer Charles Fox. The documentary provides an opportunity to learn about and re-embrace the Jewish culture that produced one of the most artistic and educated societies in Europe and it celebrates the resilience and the power of Jewish life.

Following the screening, we will be joined by **Cantor Faith Steinsneider** and **Cantor David Perper** (husband & wife) who participated in the trip to Poland documented in **100 Voices** for a Q & A about the film and their trip. Afterward, they will join **Cantor Marina Shemesh** for a mini-concert.

Cantor Faith Steinsneider Cantor Steinsneider is a cantor at the Village Temple in NYC. Born in Philadelphia and raised in Miami by music-loving parents, she was the first woman to teach chazzanut at the Jewish Theological Seminary, The Academy for Jewish Religion, and at the School of Sacred Music of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. She currently serves as Instructor of Chazzanut at both HUC and JTS. She has performed extensively, including as a soloist at Carnegie Hall and the Merkin Concert Hall.

Cantor David Perper Cantor David Perper was invested as Hazzan in 1996 from the School of Sacred Music of Hebrew Union College - Jewish Institute of Religion, in New York City, and currently serves as the cantor at Beth Haverim Shir Shalom in Mahwah, NJ. Hazzan has performed opera in Europe, the United States and Israel.
