He and his wife, Michelle, also serve as the Educators for the Jewish Learning Initiative on Campus, a program of the Orthodox Union. Rabbi Sarna was awarded the Richard M. Joel Exemplar of

Excellence from Hillel International in 2008, and was listed as one of "36-under-36 Changemakers" by the Jewish Week in 2009.
