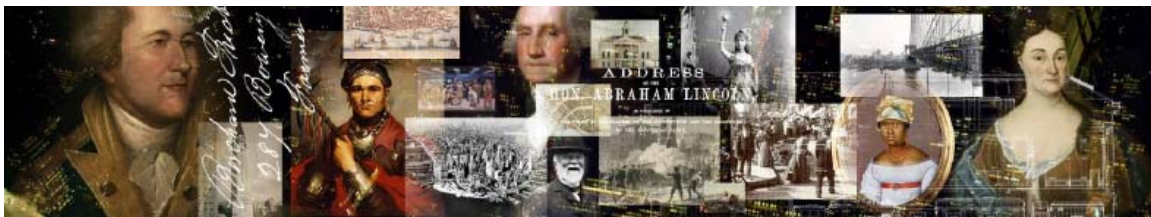


# Docent Tour of *Treasures of Shearith Israel & The Resilient City*
